**प्रस्तावना :-**

राजीव गांधी जीवनदायी आरोग्य योजना पहिल्या टप्प्यात आठ जिल्हयांत (मुंबई शहर, मुंबई उपनगर, रायगड, धुळे, नांदेड, अमरावती, सोलापूर,गडचिरोली) दिनांक २ जुलै,२०१२ रोजीपासून लागू करण्यात आली आहे तर दिनांक २१ नोव्हेंबर,२०१३ पासून संपुर्ण राज्यात ही योजना अंमलात आली आहे. ही योजना नॅशनल इन्ड्युरन्स कंपनीच्या (NIC) सहभागाने राबविण्यात येत आहे. शासन निर्णय दिनांक १३ एप्रिल,२०१७ अन्वये राजीव गांधी जीवनदायी आरोग्य योजना दिनांक १ एप्रिल, २०१७ पासून महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना (MJPJAY) या नावाने सुरु ठेवण्यास मान्यता देण्यात आली आहे. राज्यातील दारिद्रय रेषेखालील पिवळी, अंत्योदय अन्न योजना, अन्नपूर्णा योजना शिधापत्रिकाधारक कुटुंबे आणि दारिद्रयरेषेवरील (रु.१ लक्षापर्यंत वार्षिक उत्पन्न असलेल्या) केशरी

शिधापत्रिकाधारक कुटुंबे तसेच शेतकरी आत्महत्याग्रस्त १४ जिल्हयातील शुभ्र शिधापत्रिकाधारक शेतकरी कुटुंबांना महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेंतर्गत विमा संरक्षणाद्वारे वैद्यकीय सेवा पुरविण्यात येतात. सध्या या योजनेंतर्गत ३० निवडक विशेष सेवांतर्गत ९७१ प्रकारचे गंभीर व अधिक खर्चिक उपचार व १२१ शस्त्रक्रिया पश्चात सेवांचा (फॉलोअप) समावेश असून लाभार्थी रुग्णांना अंगीकृत शासकीय व खाजगी रुग्णालयामधून रोख रक्कमरहित (कॅशलेस) या वैद्यकीय सेवा उपलब्ध करून देण्यात येत आहेत. सदर योजना पूर्णतः संगणकीकृत असून लाभार्थ्यांस अनुज्ञेय शिधापत्रिका (पिवळी, अंत्योदय, अन्नपूर्णा व केशरी) व फोटो ओळखपत्राच्या आधारे अंगीकृत रुग्णालयांमधून उपचार अनुज्ञेय आहेत. योजनेंतर्गत वार्षिक विमा संरक्षण रक्कम प्रति वर्ष/ प्रति कुटुंब रु.१.५० लक्ष एवढ्या मर्यादेपर्यंत मोफत उपचार अनुज्ञेय असून मुत्रपिंड प्रत्यारोपणासाठी सदर मर्यादा रु.२.५० लक्ष एवढी आहे.

केंद्र शासनाची प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना राज्यामध्ये दिनांक २३.०९.२०१८ पासून राज्यातील शासकीय रुग्णालयांमध्ये Insurance व Assurance तत्वावर विद्यमान विमा कंपनीद्वारे पहिल्या टप्प्यामध्ये तीन महिन्याकरिता (दिनांक ३१ डिसेंबर, २०१८ पर्यंत) राबविण्यास संदर्भाधिन क्र.९ येथील दिनांक २१ सप्टेंबर, २०१८ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये मान्यता देण्यात आली आहे.

प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजनेची मुदत दिनांक ३१.१२.२०१८ रोजी संपल्यामुळे व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेस संदर्भाधिन क्र.६ येथील दिनांक १७.०१.२०१८ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये देण्यात आलेली मुदतवाढ ही दिनांक ३१.१२.२०१८ रोजी संपुष्टात आल्यामुळे सुधारीत महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना व प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना लागू होईपर्यंत किंवा सहा महिने (दिनांक ०१.०१.२०१९ ते दि.३०.०६.२०१९) यापैकी जे अगोदर घडेल त्या कालावधीपर्यंत विद्यमान महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेस व प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजनेस मुदतवाढ संदर्भाधिन क्र.११ येथील दिनांक १९.०१.२०१९ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये देण्यात आली आहे.

दिनांक १५ जानेवारी, २०१९ रोजी मुंबई येथे मा.मंत्रिमंडळाच्या बैठकीमध्ये केंद्र शासनाची प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना या दोन्ही योजना संयुक्त पध्दतीने Insurance व Assurance mode वर एकत्रितपणे राबविण्याचा निर्णय घेण्यात आला आहे. सदर निर्णयास अनुसरून प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजनेची महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेशी सांगड घालून दोन्ही योजना राज्यामध्ये राबविणे व त्यासाठी कार्यपध्दती विहित करण्याची बाब शासनाच्या विचाराधीन होती.

### शासन निर्णय :-

केंद्र शासनाची प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना या योजना संयुक्त पध्दतीने Insurance व Assurance mode वर एकत्रितपणे राबविण्यास शासन मान्यता देण्यात येत आहे.

२. **योजना राबविण्याची कार्यपध्दती :-** केंद्र शासनाची प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व राज्य शासनाची महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना या दोन्ही योजना एकत्रितपणे खालीलप्रमाणे विहित कार्यपध्दतीनुसार राज्य आरोग्य हमी सोसायटीकडून राबविण्यात येतील.

३. समित्या :- प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेच्या धोरणात्मक बाबींवर निर्णय घेण्यासाठी संदर्भाधिन क्र. ९ येथील दिनांक २१.०९.२०१८ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये मुख्य सचिव यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखाली नियामक परिषद गठीत करण्यास आली आहे. तथापि, दोन्ही योजनांची प्रभावी अंमलबजावणी होण्यासाठी योजनेत उद्भवणाऱ्या विविध तांत्रिक व महत्त्वपूर्ण बाबींवर तातडीने निर्णय घेण्यासाठी अपर मुख्य सचिव/प्रधान सचिव/सचिव, सार्वजनिक आरोग्य व कुटुंब कल्याण विभाग यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखाली राज्य सनियंत्रण व कार्यकारी समिती तसेच राज्य स्तरावर

समन्वय, अंगीकरण व शिस्तपालन समिती, अंतिम दावे निराकरण समिती, राज्य तक्रार निवारण समिती व जिल्हास्तरावर जिल्हा सनियंत्रण व तक्रार निवारण समिती अशा समित्यांचे “ परिशिष्ट -१ ” नुसार गठन करण्यात येत आहे. राज्य सनियंत्रण व कार्यकारी समितीची बैठक तीन महिन्यातून एकदा किंवा आवश्यकतेनुसार आयोजित करण्यात येईल तर एका वर्षात नियामक परिषदेच्या किमान दोन बैठका आयोजित करण्यात येतील.

४. **वित्तीय भार :-** प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना (PMJAY) योजनेतर्गत केंद्र शासनाचा हिस्सा ६० टक्के व राज्य शासनाचा हिस्सा ४० टक्के राहिल. प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजनेच्या अंमलबजावणीसाठी राज्य शासनाच्या हिश्यापोटी आवश्यक निधी व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेच्या अंमलबजावणीसाठी अर्थसंकल्पामध्ये आवश्यक निधी / अतिरिक्त अनुदान सर्वसाधारण (General), अनुसूचित जाती उप योजनेतर्गत (SCP) व अनुसूचित जमाती उप योजनेतर्गत (TSP) राज्य शासनाकडून उपलब्ध करून देण्यात येईल.

५. **विमा कंपनीची निवड :-** प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना एकत्रितपणे राबविण्यासाठी विमा कंपनीची निवड करण्याचे अधिकार दिनांक १६ सप्टेंबर, २०१६ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये अपर मुख्य सचिव वित्त विभाग यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखाली गठीत केलेल्या विमा कंपनी निवड समितीस राहतील. तसेच सदर समितीमध्ये राष्ट्रीय आरोग्य अभिकरण यांचे प्रतिनिधींचा समावेश करण्यात येत आहे. प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजना या योजनांसाठी सार्वजनिक क्षेत्रातील विमा कंपन्या बरोबरच खाजगी विमा कंपन्यांनाही सहभागी होता येईल, मात्र सार्वजनिक क्षेत्रातील विमा कंपन्यांना प्राधान्य देण्यात येईल. खाजगी विमा कंपन्यांच्या न्यूनतम दरास मॅच करण्याची संधी सार्वजनिक क्षेत्रातील विमा कंपन्यांना राहिल. या संदर्भातील अटी व शर्ती आणि निकष निश्चित करण्याचे अधिकार अपर मुख्य सचिव (वित्त) यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखालील विमा कंपनी निवड समितीस राहतील.

६. **रुग्णालयांचे अंगीकरण :-** प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेतर्गत अंगीकृत करण्यात येणाऱ्या रुग्णालयांची प्रत्येक तालुक्यात किमान २ रुग्णालये याप्रमाणे महसूली विभाग निहाय संख्या निश्चित करण्याचे, राज्याच्या सर्व महसूल विभागात एकसमान पध्दतीने रुग्णालयांचे जाळे तयार करणे इ. बाबत निर्णय घेण्याचे अधिकार सचिव/प्रधान सचिव/ अ.मु.स., सार्वजनिक आरोग्य विभाग यांना राहिल. अंगीकृत रुग्णालयांच्या संख्येमध्ये आवश्यकतेनुसार १००० रुग्णालयापर्यंत वाढ करण्यात येईल.

७. **उपचार :-** प्रधानमंत्री जन आरोग्य योजना व महात्मा ज्योतिबा फुले जन आरोग्य योजनेच्या एकूण उपचारांची संख्या निश्चित करणे, उपचारांच्या संख्येत बदल करण्याचे (कमी/जास्त), वर्णनात व दरात बदल करण्याचे व काही उपचार शासकीय रुग्णालयांसाठी राखीव ठेवण्याचे अधिकार सचिव/प्रधान सचिव/अ.मु.स., सार्वजनिक आरोग्य विभाग यांना राहतील.

८. **योजनेतील रूग्णालये :-** सदर योजनांसाठी राज्य आरोग्य हमी सोसायटी निश्चित करेल अशा निकषानुसार खाजगी रूग्णालयांचा, विश्वस्त संस्थांच्या रूग्णालयांचा व शासकीय रूग्णालयांचा समावेश करण्यात येईल. सदर रूग्णालयांचा योजनेमध्ये समावेश करण्याची कार्यवाही राज्य आरोग्य हमी सोसायटी आणि निवड केलेली विमा कंपनी करेल.
